COVID-19 UPDATE

To the residents of Terrestria:

During these unprecedented times of heath and financial upheaval; the Board of Directors are taking the following actions to protect the health of the community and financial liquidity of our association.

1. Following the recommendations of the State of NJ, closing the clubhouse and associated public areas (Basketball/tennis courts & play area).
2. Closing the office to non-essential traffic, we ask that all communications be via phone or email until further notice.
3. Place on hold all community improvements projects and re-evaluate on a month to month basis.
4. The Association was approved for the SBA Paycheck Protection Program for \$24,580 on May 4th which will help alleviate any financial impact from the pandemic. We will carefully follow the guidelines so the loan is forgiven and the Association will not have to pay anything on the loan.
5. Urge all residents to follow the CDC guidelines on Steps **to Prevent Getting Sick** (which includes social distancing).

PROJECTS UPATE

Vie Jo Paint Project—The paint project was completed on March 23rd. The final payment of \$23,500 was made on May 26th. The project is paid in full for \$93,500.

Heath, Thornhill and Elena Roof Project- The roofing project began in January for Thornhill and Heath Courts which was completed February 28th and payment has been made in full of \$83,991 as we completed each building. Elena Court is the last section for this project. Cost \$55,950. Elena Court's roof replacements was scheduled to start March 16th but was temporarily postponed due to the unexpected financial impact of the pandemic. Everlast began replacing the roofs on the first of 2 buildings in Elena Court on June 1st. Thank you to the Elena residents for your patience during this delay.

Tennis/Basketball Court Renovations- This renovation is on hold pending further notice on our month to month reviews of financials.

Replacement of Railroad ties- Project on hold pending further notice on our month to month reviews of financials.

Restriping of Court Parking Lots- Maintenance has begun the restriping project. The next court to be striped is Burberry Court.

Gloucester Township Sealcoating and Repaving of Courts- The Township did patch work in Sonora and Jaeger Court on March 24th and 26th. According to the Township's letter the project will commence for repaving late spring, early summer. We will update you on these courts and the sealcoating of Ashford Glen once we receive more information.

PAYMENT PLANS AND ARRANGEMENTS

Due to the coronavirus pandemic and the State of New Jersey's order to shelter in at home we are well aware many of our residents are or will be experiencing financial difficulties. Individual Maintenance Issues

ARB INSPECTIONS

ARB inspections began in April—weather permitting. Inspect your home and property to make any necessary repairs or replacements:

Front and Back yard cleaning, pressure washing of the exterior of your home and fencing, replacement of cloudy glass windows or doors, garage door repairs or replacement, replacement/repair of any damaged/rotted wood, replacement/repair/painting of decks and fencing, etc.

Check your Rules and Regulations booklet to see what is your responsibility as a homeowner. Please do not wait for a violation notice and/or fine.

2020 POOL SEASON UPDATE

Our pool company is keeping us updated on any news pertaining to the pool opening and the covid-19 crisis. At this time we are operating with the assumption that the pool will be open at some point this summer once the Governor starts to lessen some of the restrictions. We will update you as soon as we have more information. At this time pool tags ARE NOT available for purchase. We will inform you when we will begin selling pool tags.

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

Please remember to pick up your dog's feces on the grounds as it is a Township Pet Ordinance and a health hazard. In addition, it is part of the Township's Pet Ordinance that all dogs must be on a leash when walking through the community.

LANDSCAPING SERVICES SCHEDULE

Marksmen will begin pruning front yard and common area shrubs the week of June 15th.
Our weekly lawn cut is Thursdays.

Please place out the appropriate color flags at the edge of your lawn by the street or by your mailbox by the curb, if you DO NOT want the service. If you need flags, please call the office and we will deliver them to your home.

RED FLAG- NO GRASS CUT
YELLOW FLAG- NO PRUNING
BLUE FLAG- NO FERTILIZERS/PESTICIDES

SUMMER GUTTER CLEANING

Marksmen will begin the summer gutter cleaning the end of June. A reminder that we do not have the contractor remove or re-install your gutter guards during the clean out process due to the liability to the Association, if the guards get damaged.

Please note that the contractor may need to use your outside faucet during the process. If you do not want them using your faucet, please place a blue flag in front of it. They will only use the faucet, if they need to clear out the downspout.

HALL RENTAL

All hall rentals have been cancelled from March 21st through June 30th by order of the State of New Jersey. We are not scheduling any new hall rentals at this time until we have a definitive date of the ending of social distancing and the State announces social events can re-commence. We do have the events scheduled for July 1st through December 31st pending new updates from the State of NJ. We are currently not booking any new events at this time. The hall cannot be viewed as it is closed to walk in traffic due to the compliance of the State of New Jersey Covid-19 order.
