2022 POOL SEASON

The pool season will start Memorial Day weekend- May 28, 29, and 30.

Hours 11 am – 8 pm for weekends only until June 18th.

It will open full time June 18th through September 5th. Weekend/Holiday hours 11 am – 8 pm and Weekdays 12 pm – 8 pm.

Pool forms can be obtained from the Pool Monitor station at the pool entrance, at the office or on our website. It is \$10 per resident tag. \$ 5 per guest day tag. You can purchase a 10 visit guest tag for \$40 in the office.

If any changes are made by the CDC, State of NJ, Board of Health or the Board of Directors, the changes will be posted at the pool area, the next newsletter, and on our website. For insurance reasons our pool will continue to be for the use of our residents only and their guests. We will not be selling pool tags to non-residents to use the pool as per the change that was made in 2020.

PROJECTS UPATE

Replacement of Railroad ties- 2022 replacement of railroad ties with EP Henry block started in March. The ties being replaced this year are small edging wall at the center median in the back section of Del Sol \$12,000, small edging wall by the overflow parking of little Jaeger and Big Jaeger \$11,000, corner wall of Elena Court \$12,000 (which has been completed 3/25/22), and Keats Court a low edging wall around center median \$25,000. The Keats Court parking lot railroad ties planter will be removed and the area asphalted due to vehicles repeatedly hitting it.

Many repairs have already been done to completed walls in Byron and Burberry Court due to vehicles hitting the walls. Please be mindful of the walls while parking your vehicles or driving! If you hit the wall and cause damage, by law you are to report it to the police and the office so an insurance claim can be filed with your insurance company. It is not free for the association to repair already completed walls. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation regarding this issue.

STRIPING AND ASSIGN PARKING UPDATE- The professional striping of the parking spots in the courts started in December. We will notify each individual court about the assign parking once the striping is completed and the assign parking is diagrammed for each court. This way any issues can be worked out prior to the actual painting of the assign parking lettering.

This will ensure each homeowner will have one assign parking spot by their home. It will be the homeowner's responsibility to direct their guests to the guest parking spots in their court so they do not park in a homeowner's parking spot. We have amended our towing signs for vehicles to be towed, if it becomes a problem of someone parking in another homeowner's assign parking spot.

Roof Project: The 2022 roofing project will be Vie Jo Court. Cost: \$127,365. The scheduled start date has yet to be determined but the expected start date is expected to be early summer. The remainder of roofs to be replaced will be done in 2023- Keats Court and Canterbury Court. Cost: \$116,915. That would complete all court roof replacements projects in the community.

Rainer Painting : All courts have been painted since 2011. We now begin the process again from the starting point of Sonora Court. Sonora Court will be painted this summer. Cost: \$60,000. We will notify the court with the Contractor/Resident Paint Project meeting once it is determined.

John Deer Gator: The association's gator will be replaced this year as the old one is over 20 years old and has served the association well. Cost: \$13,000.

ARB INSPECTIONS

ARB inspections will begin in May. Please inspect your home and property to make any necessary repairs or replacements:

Yard clean up (front and back yards), removal of trash and debris on property, weeding/tending of garden beds, pressure washing of exterior of your siding and fencing, replacement of cloudy glass windows or doors, garage door repair/replacement, replacement/repair of damaged rotten wood on home and sheds, replacement/repair/painting of decks and fences etc., tidy up patio/deck furniture etc.

TRAFFIC LIGHT AT SICKLERVILLE AND STONEBRIDGE ROAD PETITION

At the July 20th Resident Meeting the issues of increased volume of traffic on Sicklerville Road creating a safety issue making a left turn onto Sicklerville Road from Stonebridge Road was discussed and it was decided that Terrestria will bring the issue to the Gloucester Township Council.
