TERRESTRIA BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

Jason Cocco (President) and **Alex Walker** (Board Member) were re-elected to the 2-year terms. **John Blanchard** (Board Member/ARB Liason) and **Anthony Micale** (Board Treasurer) were re-elected to the 1-year terms.

George Bosco (Vice-President) and **Theresa Myers** (Secretary) were re-elected to the 2-year terms in 2021.

Thank you to the Board of Directors for your dedication to our community and volunteering your time to serve our Association. It is very much appreciated by everyone.

PROJECTS UPATE

Replacement of Railroad ties- 2022 replacement of railroad ties with EP Henry block started in March. The ties being replaced this year are small edging wall at the center median in the back section of Del Sol \$12,000, small edging wall by the overflow parking of little Jaeger and Big Jaeger \$11,000, corner wall of Elena Court \$12,000 (which has been completed 3/25/22), and Keats Court a low edging wall around center median \$25,000. All of the railroad ties replacements for this budget year have been completed.

The Keats Court parking lot railroad ties planter will be removed and the area asphalted due to vehicles repeatedly hitting it.

Many repairs have already been done to completed walls in Byron and Burberry Court due to vehicles hitting the walls. Please be mindful of the walls while parking your vehicles or driving! If you hit the wall and cause damage, by law you are to report it to the police and the office so an insurance claim can be filed with your insurance company. It is not free for the association to repair already completed walls. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation regarding this issue.

STRIPING AND ASSIGN PARKING UPDATE- The professional striping of the parking spots in the courts started in December. We will notify each individual court about the assign parking once the striping is completed and the assign parking is diagrammed for each court. This way any issues can be worked out prior to the actual painting of the assign parking lettering.

This will ensure each homeowner will have one assign parking spot by their home. It will be the homeowner's responsibility to direct their guests to the guest parking spots in their court so they do not park in a homeowner's parking spot. We have amended our towing signs for vehicles to be towed, if it becomes a problem of someone parking in another homeowner's assign parking spot.

Roof Project: The 2022 roofing project will be Vie Jo Court. Cost: \$127,365. The roofing project began in October and will be completed by January. The remainder of roofs to be replaced will be done in 2023- Keats Court and Canterbury Court. Cost: \$116,915. That would complete all court roof replacements projects in the community.

John Deer Gator: The association's gator will be replaced this year as the old one is over 20 years old and has served the association well. Cost: \$13,000.

Rainer Painting Project : All courts have been painted since 2011. We now begin the process again from the starting point of Sonora Court. The painting project started in November. Cost: \$60,000.

FALL GUTTER CLEANING

The fall gutter cleaning began the first week of December. A reminder that we do not have the contractor remove or re-install gutter guards during the cleaning process due to the liability to the Association, if the guards are damaged.

LEAF COLLECTION

Marksmen will begin the second leaf collection the first two weeks of December. To make this program a success, please comply with the following rules:

Keep all leaves unbagged at curbside. If you must use bags, please use paper bags only.

Have all leaves out the weekend prior to the start date.

Rake all leaves from your backyard to the front of your house. Do not rake leaves into the street, if it will block traffic.

Do not mix trash and broken branches with leaves. This clogs the machines and your leaves will not be picked up.

Do not park any vehicles in front of the leaves during the collection week. The leaves will not be picked up.

The single-family homes are included in the December leaf collection.

In addition, look out for Gloucester Township's signs on the road for Public Works leaf collection dates for Terrestria.

Yard cleanup (front and back yards), removal of trash and debris on property, weeding/tending of garden beds, pressure washing of exterior of your siding and fencing, replacement of cloudy glass windows or doors, garage door repair/replacement, replacement/repair of damaged rotten wood on home and sheds, replacement/repair/painting of decks and fences etc., tidy up patio/deck furniture etc.
